- A **2.5% discount** is available where the Annual Fees and Levies are paid in full and received at the College within 30 days after the Annual Account is issued early Term 1.
- PAYMENT PLAN DISCOUNT: A discount of 1.5%** is available where: **1)** An approved regular payment schedule has been established with the initial payment received at the college within 30 days of the Term 1 statement issue date **AND 2)** the periodic payments under the payment schedule are maintained **AND 3)** the total annual fees and levies charge is paid in full and received at the college by the end of Term 4 Week 4, as per the approved schedule.

2024 Fee and Levy Information

1. **Diocesan Secondary College Building Levy:** Each family will be charged a building Levy of \$615.50 per year in conjunction with normal school fee billing except where families have children attending Catholic Primary Schools in the Diocese of Rockhampton.
2. **School Based-Levies:** Are charges for curriculum resources, library resources and student learning materials. These levies are set by the School Board - to be no greater than 25% of the non-discounted tuition fees per student.
3. **Specific Purpose Levy:** Additional charges for specific purposes eg. Motivational Media, Youth Challenge, Student Diary, College Calendar, Subject Sport Bus transport costs, School photo ID card, College Year Book, Champagnat Day activities, Careers Market, ICAS Competitions, Student Accident Insurance Cover, subjects requiring additional materials (computer, art, technology design, home economics, graphics), First aid supplies, Swimming Carnival entry, Footsteps and technology costs.
4. **Technology Capital Levy:** An annual Technology Capital Levy of \$130 per student. The levy is used strictly for technology capital purposes at the College.
5. **Camps/Excursions:** Major Subject/Sport excursions, Year 12 Retreat, Year Camps etc. will incur other costs and these will be communicated to the parents/guardians via the Parent Lounge Portal, or by email.
6. Families may be eligible for school fee assistance under the **Concession Card Tuition Fee Discount and/or the Principal's Concession Scheme.**

Concession Card Tuition Fee Discount: A 70% Tuition Fee Discount is available for 'means tested' Government Health Care (HCC) and Pensioner concession cards. These cards must meet eligibility criteria for this concession to apply (eg. HCC Eligibility guide).

Principal's Concession Scheme: Total or partial exemption from the payment of fees and levies is available for families experiencing hardship, who provide appropriate supporting evidence. All applications are assessed fairly and treated confidentially by the Principal. For further information please contact the Business Manager.

School EasyPay

Introducing in 2024 a New Direct Debit Payment Platform via your Parent Lounge

At Marist College we are always looking at ways to improve the services we provide to our community and our operational efficiency. The College is pleased to offer an improved solution for the payment of school fees by direct debit.

A paperless direct debit system within TASS Parent Lounge has been implemented, which will efficiently and effectively manage all direct debit payments. School EasyPay system provides a secure payment platform, increases flexibility by allowing families to manage and track their school payments throughout the year from within TASS Parent Lounge and provides a more cost-effective solution for all families.

There are numerous advantages to the School EasyPay system including;

Flexibility – parents can choose to pay via credit / debit card, bank account or both.

Convenience – families have the ability to tailor a payment arrangement to suit their needs. Payments can be made quarterly, monthly, or fortnightly on dates that are most convenient.

Secure payments – no need for families to share credit card details and payment platform is 100% PCI compliant.

Save time and improve cashflow – establish a direct debit payment schedule so school fees become more manageable and never forget a payment.

Improved communication – automated email advice to keep families aware of upcoming payment dates and amounts
