


# How to access Microsoft programs at home



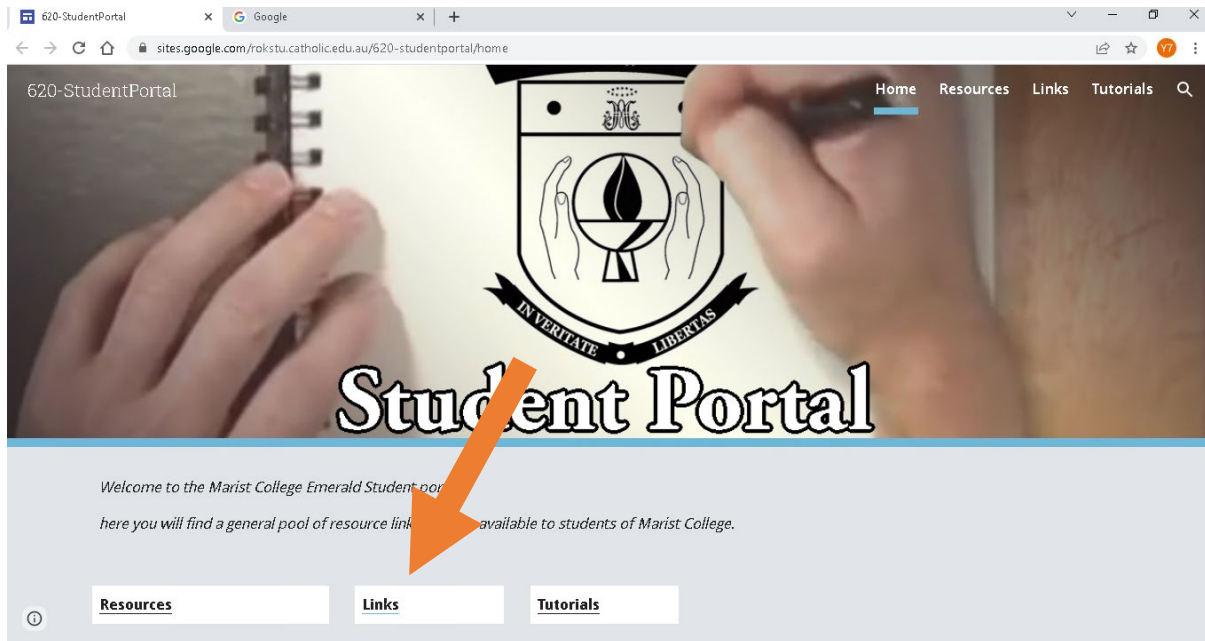

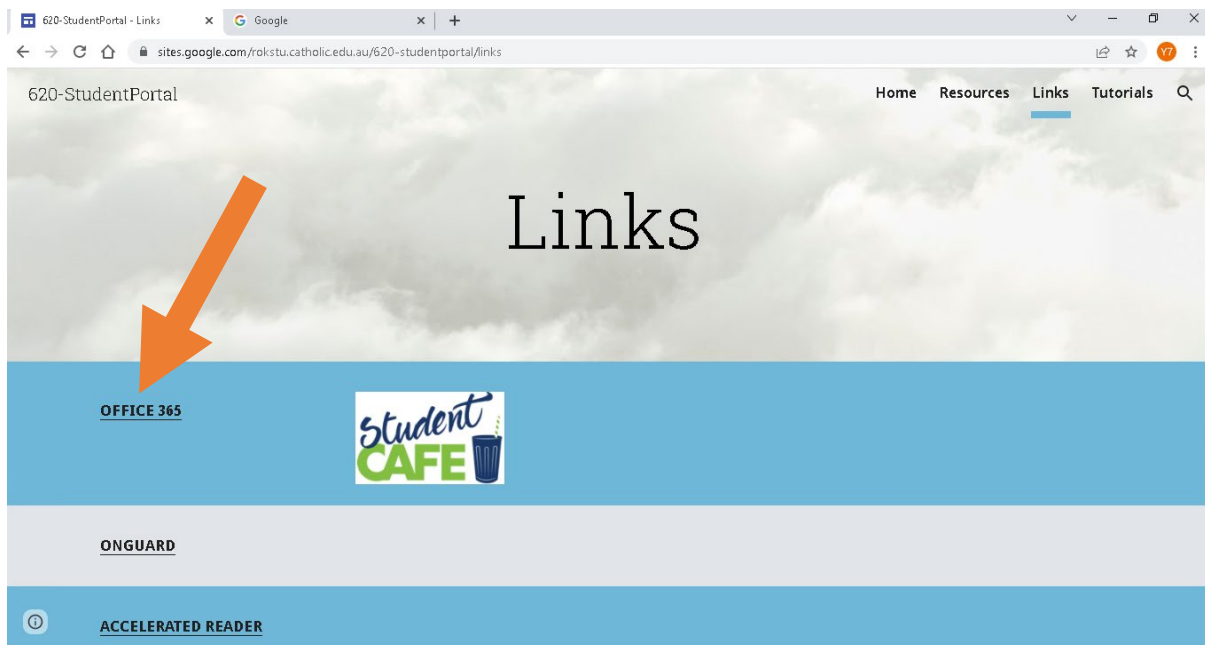

## Office 365:

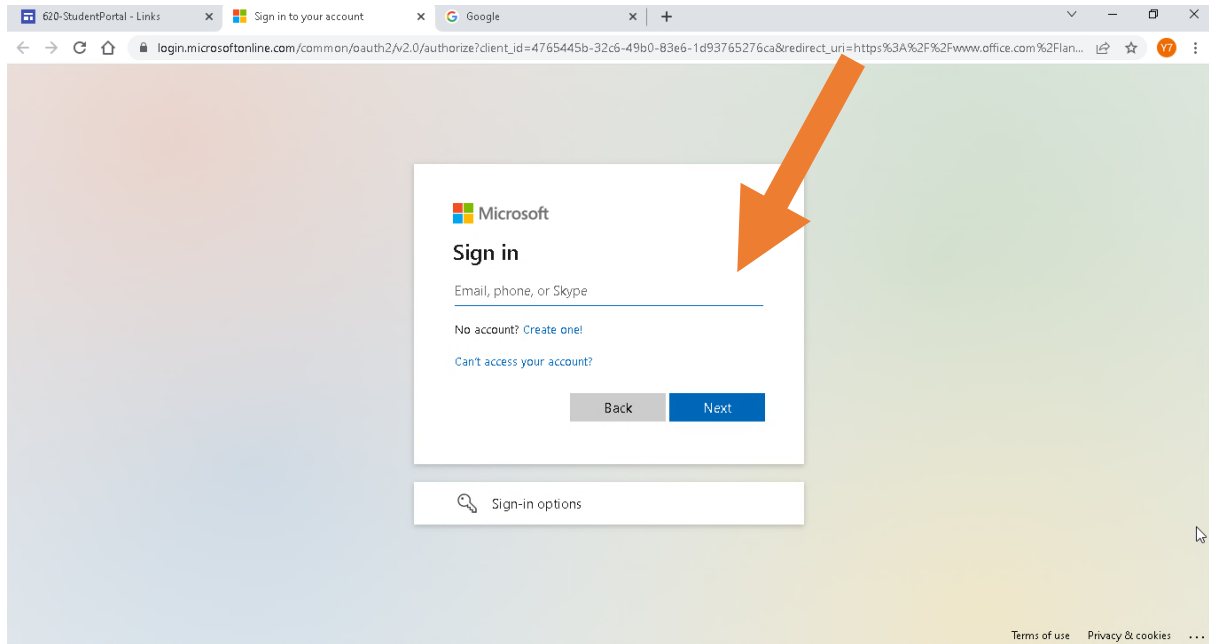
Step 1: go to student portal and click on links.



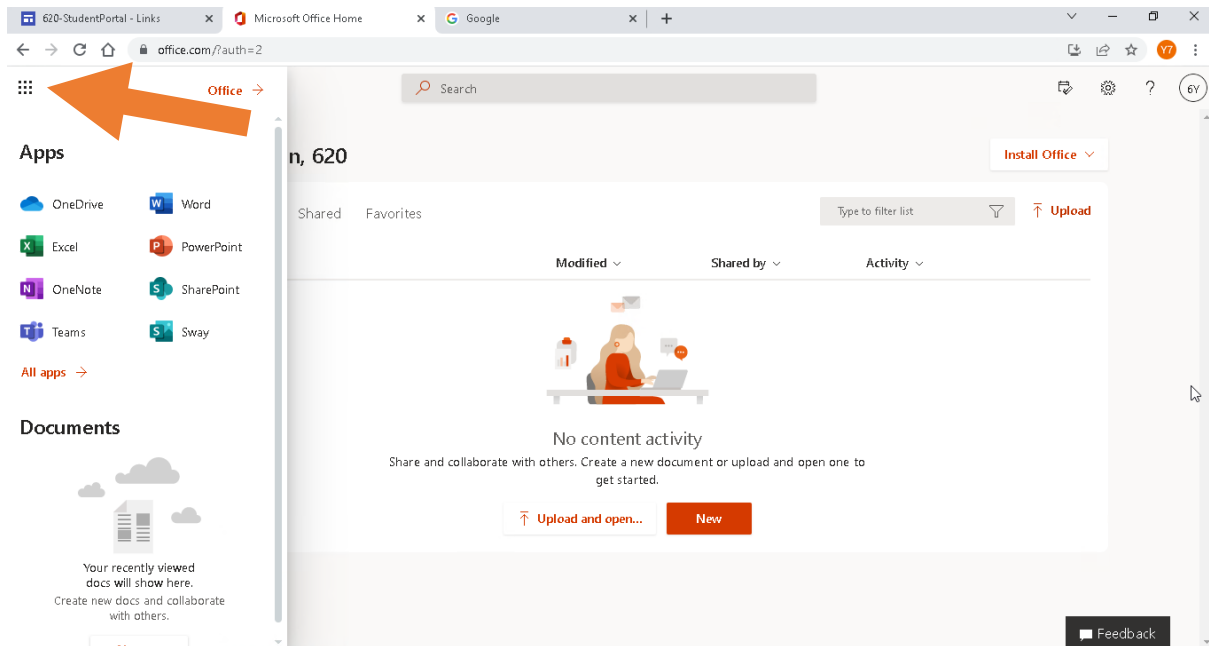
Step 2: Click on the link that says OFFICE 365.



Step 3: log in using the students' email (which is the students' username with @rokstu.catholic.edu.au on the end).

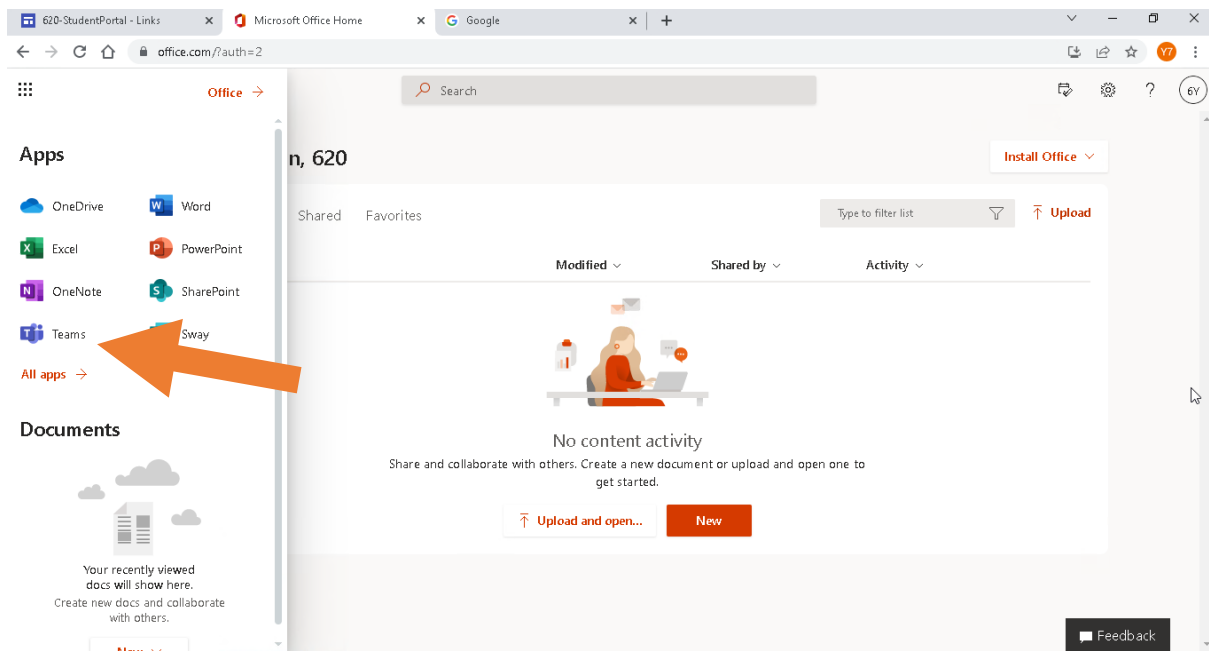


Step 5: Click the 9 dots on the top left to list all the apps in Office 365.
